

Presidential Speeches of the Americas Dataset and Archive

Table 1 summarizes the sources and data availability of the Presidential Speeches of the Americas dataset and archive. As described in the manuscript, our data collection began in earnest in July of 2016, and continued through September of 2016. The data were scraped using the web scraping software *Outwit Hub*. In the cases of El Salvador, Nicaragua and Brazil, additional sources of presidential speech data were discovered and added to the archive in early 2017; Bolivia was added in the summer of 2018. Most of the data were publicized on the official websites of the presidencies, though in the case of Venezuela and Nicaragua we relied on third-party online archives to source the data. In the cases of Costa Rica, Panama and Honduras, additional historical archives of speeches were accessed via the WayBack Machine Internet Archive.

In columns 1-3 of Table 1 we summarize for each country the date of first access, as well as the original url where the speeches were contained. In column 5 of Table 1, we have endeavored to provide updated web addresses where more contemporary speeches and public appearances may be found (updated in July, 2018), though there is no guarantee that the speeches contained in the PSA data will be accessible, or that these links will remain relevant into the future. This is due to the frequent updating of presidential websites, and the common practice of website redesign with the entrance of a new president coming to office.

Columns 6 to 15 of Table 1 summarize the sort of information available about each public appearance on a country by country basis. We designed each automated web-scraping script to collect as much information as was available on each country's respective website. As reported in the manuscript, our data contain speech transcripts for approximately 82% of the observations, though that coverage varies considerably cross-nationally.¹ The most readily available pieces of information were the speech title and the date. As for location, only the Brazilian, Colombian, American (U.S) and Venezuelan websites explicitly listed the location of the public appearance, but we have captured that whenever possible.²

¹We acknowledge here that we have not verified the availability of transcripts in all observations in our data, but have confirmed that this is the case for the sample of the data we coded (described in more detail below). What is more, as most of our speech data is contained in .csv files, extremely long speeches may be cut off by some spreadsheet or statistical software packages owing to the character limits said software imposes. Accordingly, the data contained in the PSA dataset and archive may be appropriate for some applications (i.e. coding for content, tone, audience or location), though users are encouraged to proceed with caution in other applications (i.e. quantitative text analysis).

²Per our coding of the PSA data, the location was a readily discernible parameter from the reading of the speeches. Our coders were able to identify a location of the public appearance roughly 60% of the time.
